COURSE OBJECTIVE

Upon completion of all the training modules of Construction Carpentry NC Level 2, the trainee will be able to do the following:

- Carryout basic wood work,
- Construct and remove formwork and scaffolding
- Carryout ceiling, flooring, partition and staircase construction work
- Construct Doors, Windows and Shutters
- Perform Roofing work
- Perform repair and maintenance works

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Construction Carpentry National Certificate Level 2 qualification recognizes the skills and knowledge required for people working as a skilled construction carpenter.

This course is designed to provide the knowledge, skills and attitudes of an individual to become competent as Construction carpenter in accordance with industry standards. Upon completion of this course the graduates will be able to work in the construction industry where they can perform construction services such as: performing wood work, constructing and removing formwork and scaffolding, carrying out ceiling, flooring, partition and staircase construction work, constructing doors, windows and shutters, performing roofing work and performing repair and maintenance of civil works.

The course will also prepare the graduates to comply with regulatory and organizational requirements for practicing Occupational Health and Safety procedures.

To obtain the qualification of Construction Carpentry NC2, all modules and learning outcomes prescribed for this qualification must be achieved.
